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HOUSING TERMS GLOSSARY

AMI (Area Median Income)

The midpoint income for a region, as calculated annually by HUD. Affordable housing eligibility is often expressed as a percentage of AMI (e.g., “60% AMI and below”) — the lower the percentage, the lower the income limit to qualify.

HCV (Housing Choice Voucher)

Formerly known as “Section 8.” A federal rental subsidy, administered locally by a housing authority, that pays a portion of rent directly to a landlord on behalf of an eligible low-income tenant.

HUD

U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. The federal agency that oversees fair housing law, public housing funding, and most affordable housing programs referenced in this guide.

CDBG-DR (Community Development Block Grant – Disaster Recovery)

A HUD grant program that funds long-term disaster recovery efforts, including home repair and reconstruction, in federally declared disaster areas. Renew NC’s housing programs are funded through CDBG-DR.

Tax Credit Property

A property built or renovated using Low-Income Housing Tax Credits (LIHTC), a federal incentive that requires owners to keep a set share of units affordable to lower-income renters, typically for 15–30 years.

Income-Based / Income-Restricted

Rent is set according to a household’s income (income-based) or capped so it cannot exceed a set percentage of the local median (income-restricted), rather than being set purely at market rate.

30% of Adjusted Income

A common eligibility formula, especially in senior and disability housing, in which a household pays no more than 30% of its adjusted gross income toward rent, with a subsidy covering the remainder.

Housing Authority

A local public agency that owns and operates public housing and administers voucher programs. In this guide, this refers to the Asheville Housing Authority (HACA) and similar county-level authorities.

OUR COMMITMENT TO AFFORDABLE HOUSING

The City of Asheville remains committed to affordable housing in our community and hopes this guide is a helpful resource for individuals and families looking for a great place to live and prosper that they can afford. The U.S. Department of Housing & Urban Development (HUD) defines affordable housing as not spending more than 30% of your gross income on housing costs. For renters, this includes rent & utilities. For homeowners, this includes your mortgage, insurance and property taxes. Please know the City is dedicated to helping produce, preserve & protect healthy affordable mixed-income communities with a variety of housing types at a variety of price points, both homeownership and rental, for the variety of incomes & wages we produce in Asheville.

ASHEVILLE HOUSING AUTHORITY

Housing Authority of the City of Asheville (HACA) has grown to 10 public housing developments with 1,534 units, 248 special program units and administers the Housing Choice Voucher Program to subsidize housing for more than 1,355 low-income individuals and families. From the Great Depression to the Information Age, HACA has given families and others a chance to come home to a place that is more than just an address.

BUNCOMBE COUNTY AFFORDABLE HOUSING COMMITTEE

Buncombe County is committed to the work of ensuring comprehensive opportunities for affordable and safe housing as a foundation for healthy and thriving families and neighborhoods in our community.

FAIR HOUSING

The Fair Housing act is a federal law enforced by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). The Fair Housing Act protects tenants and prospective homebuyers of any race, color, religion, national origin or gender, including people with disabilities and families with children, against housing discrimination. For complaints related to fair housing or housing discrimination please contact the Fair Housing Project at 1-855-797-FAIR(3247).

EXAMPLES OF HOUSING DISCRIMINATION

- Refusal to rent or sell housing or otherwise deal with an interested tenant or buyer.
- Real estate professionals or companies steering customers to certain neighborhoods or making claims about the racial makeup of an area.

- Lying about the availability of housing by telling people of color, families or disabled individuals that an apartment is already taken, when it is not.
- Refusing to permit reasonable accommodations for assistive aides, assistive animals, parking, or physical modifications to existing properties.

If you feel like you have been discriminated against you may contact the following agencies and file a complaint:

PISGAH LEGAL SERVICES (PLS)

PLS has the Homelessness Prevention Project for those in danger of eviction or foreclosure or living in substandard conditions. PLS provides legal aid to:

- Prevent eviction and foreclosure, including mobile home parks
- Improve substandard housing condition
- Obtain or preserve eligibility for housing subsidies
- Help with discrimination and disability accommodation
- Provide protection for seniors, veterans, people living with HIV/AIDS

Pisgah Legal Services reminds all renters that the law requires them to continue paying their rent while seeking help for substandard conditions and discrimination.

HURRICANE HELENE RECOVERY HOUSING

Hurricane Helene caused widespread housing damage across Western North Carolina. The resources below are specific to recovery, repair, and rebuilding assistance for those impacted by the storm.

- State program funded by \$1.4 billion HUD Community Development Block Grant Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) grant
- For homeowners whose primary residence was damaged by Hurricane Helene
- Offers repairs, stick-built reconstruction, manufactured home replacement, and reimbursement for completed repairs
- Prioritizes low-to-moderate income families
- Serves 29 NC counties impacted by Helene, including Buncombe
- Program manages and completes construction; homeowners cannot select their own contractors
- Intake centers in Asheville, Boone, and Marion; helpline and email support available

FEMA Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (Buyouts)

Contact via Buncombe County Helene Resource Center

- For homeowners in flood-damaged or high-risk properties
- Property owners negotiate a pre-disaster fair market value with the state
- Once purchased, structures are demolished and land is deeded to the county as open space/greenway
- As of mid-2026, over 250 Buncombe County properties have been approved out of 278 submitted

Reduce to Rebuild — Buncombe County Fee Waivers

Contact Buncombe County Permits & Inspections Department

- Reduced permitting fees for Helene-impacted residences (Destroyed, Major, Moderate, or Minor damage ratings)
- Applies to Planning, Permits & Inspections, Air Quality, and Onsite/Wastewater fees
- Does not apply to residence expansions or homeowner recovery/lien agent fees

- Available to income-eligible homeowners and renters statewide
